

Environmental Policy

To ensure that all activities undertaken by Smiles CM Ltd. comply with all current or proposed discharge consent standards enforced by the Environment Agency, or other regulatory bodies, the directors, managers and staff are committed to ensuring that all systems adhere to the following principles:

- They are appropriate to the nature, scale and environmental impacts of its activities, products or services
- Includes a commitment to continual improvement and prevention of pollution
- Includes a commitment to comply with relevant environmental legislation or regulations, and with other requirements to which the organisation subscribes
- Provides the framework for setting and reviewing environmental objectives and targets
- Is documented, implemented and maintained and communicated to all employees
- Is available to the public if requested
- Establish and maintain a procedure(s) to identify the environmental aspects of its activities, products or services that it can control and over which it can be expected to have an influence, in order to determine those that have or can have significant impacts on the environment.
- Ensure that the aspects related to these significant impacts are considered in setting its environmental objectives.
- Establish and maintain a procedure to identify and have access to legal and other requirements to which the organisation subscribes, that are applicable to the environmental aspects of its activities, products or services.

When establishing and reviewing its objectives, the company will consider the legal and other requirements, its significant environmental aspects, its technological options and its financial, operational and business requirements, and the views of interested parties.

The objectives and targets shall be consistent with the environmental policy, including the commitment to prevention of pollution.

It is the policy of the Company to take all reasonable or practicable steps to reduce any risk to the Environment caused as a by-product of our activities or processes.

Elimination	Wherever possible substances not absolutely essential to our processes will be eliminated.
Substitution	Wherever possible environmentally friendly substances will replace less friendly products as they appear on the market.
Control	Provision of such control measures such as ventilation, reclamation, re-cycling and the prevention of pollutants contaminating soil or the atmosphere will be an on-going feature of this policy.
Removal of Waste Material	Where pollutants in liquid, solid or dust form are a by-product of an activity or process these will be stored in suitable containers to prevent leakage until removed from the premises by subcontracted registered specialist companies operating within our industry
